

## HIRING LOCAL PEOPLE AT HAWA & JPL

Job preference is given to local community members for unskilled labour needs at the Hawa and JPL project sites. These jobs include security watchmen and teaching staff. As of December 2021, JPL employed 29 watchmen at the turbines, four watchmen at the masts, and three teachers from the neighboring villages, while Hawa employed 29 watchmen at the turbines and two watchmen at the masts. Employment opportunities have therefore provided a source of stable income to local people in a region where the employment rate is only 18%.

"I am greatly obliged to JPL for giving me a job. I was unskilled and was barely living hand to mouth. Now I have a job, and I get a salary which has made my life worth living. I am now a trained watchman, and I can get the job anywhere. I am taking care of myself and my family needs in a much better way as compared to when I was unemployed. I enjoy peace of mind as a result. Thank you, JPL."
