



QUALITY EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AT JPL

The JPL Project provides ongoing educational support to schools in the region through the provision of educational materials and financial support for a teacher's salary. During the construction phase, the Project constructed and now continues to maintain a primary school building that caters to approximately 30 children aged between six and ten years old. The Project also provided furniture and books and hired a teacher to support the delivery of the syllabus to the school children. The teacher has been retained for the two-year Operation and Management (O&M) contract.

The on-site JPL team visits the school on a monthly basis to evaluate whether all appropriate materials are available and ensure that teachers and learners are in attendance. Thus far the Project's support has resulted in an increased level of engagement and attendance at the school as the average number of regular students attending school has increased from 19 to 28 in 2019.
