

HAWA/JPL PROVISION OF CLEAN WATER

Hawa/JPL have provided access to water tanks which are filled with clean water on a monthly basis throughout the reporting period. In 2020, a total of 2,772,000 litres of water was provided by Hawa while 3,024,000 litres of water was provided by JPL. In 2021, Hawa/JPL delivered 2,520,000 litres of water to the community.

Community members are required to regularly clean all 21 of the 10,000 litres water tanks (as a way of achieving community-level buy-in towards maintaining and using the tanks). Community members are also trained in how to boil water and use it for practicing good hygiene. The provision of clean water has relieved labour burdens for women in the community

and children (including girls) who previously travelled far to collect rainwater, which prevented the children from attending school.

Water provision has also had knock-on effects on community health since the projects also sensitised on the use of clean water for sanitation and hygiene purposes. Thank you, Hawa/JPL, for providing water at our doorstep. We used to travel a long distance to fetch water and that too was dirty and insufficient. This provision has changed our life in terms of hygiene, cooking and other domestic utilities.
